Citizens who have no access to a vehicle capable of transporting items to the landfill, are asked to contact Keep Alliance Beautiful at 762-1729. Their offices will begin accepting pick-up requests on Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. The City will provide a vehicle only and requests that able bodied citizens load their material into the vehicle. Clean Up Days are for residential customers of the City of Alliance only. All business and commercial companies will be required to pay normal landfill disposal fees. The operating hours of the Alliance Landfill are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Please call Larry Heinrich at 762-1907 for more information.
