**B. Ordinance No. 2641 – First Reading  
Municipal Code Amendment – Requests to be Placed on Council Agendas**

Ordinance No. 2641 is before Council on first reading. This ordinance will amend the Alliance Municipal Code at Chapter 1, Article 1, Sections 104 and 112. The amendment will require individuals desiring to be on a Council agenda to make their request seven business days prior to the meeting. This will allow staff to review the request, prepare any necessary materials and distribute within the normal agenda preparation schedule. In some cases the request may be able to be handled administratively without Council action.

**C. Public Hearing  
Resolution No. 09-78 – Liquor License Request**

Now is the date, time and place to conduct a public hearing on the Class D Liquor License Request of Santokh Singh dba Nick's Gas & Liquor located at 224 East 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. Resolution No. 09-78A recommends approval of the application to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission and Resolution No. 09-78B recommends denial to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission. The Alliance Police Department has conducted a background investigation and there are no violations to prohibit the issuance of the license. A copy of the application has been made part of the Council packet for your review.

**D. Resolution No. 09-79 – Fire Department Statue Request**

Resolution No. 09-79 is before Council to accept a donation from the Alliance Volunteer Fire Department (AVFD) of a statue for placement in front of the Alliance Area Fire/Emergency Center. The statue is a life-size firefighter and will serve as a memorial to all past members of the Alliance Volunteer Fire Department, and not one individual. Once approved by Council, the AVFD will begin fund raising activities for the purchase of the statue and installation costs.

**E. Resolution No. 09-80 – Law Enforcement Center Repairs/City Council Contingency Funds**

This resolution will authorize the use of \$5,421.00 from the City Council Contingency Fund for repairs to the Regional Law Enforcement Center. The City of Alliance has an Agreement with Box Butte County which identifies the City's responsibility for 25% of maintenance costs for the furnace and air conditioning. Police Chief Kiss has prepared a memorandum outlining the problems and the proposed expenses which has been made part of the packet for your review. A listing of previous Council Contingency authorizations has also been included.

**F. Resolution No. 09-81 – Memorandum of Agreement with Federal Aviation Administration**

Resolution No. 09-81 authorizes the City of Alliance to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Federal Aviation Administration. The MOA covers required land sites and easements for existing navigational aid facilities on the airport property. The MOA will take the place of several leases that are in existence and will reduce the amount of paperwork currently being required.

**G. Board Appointment and Resignation**

The City is in receipt of the resignation of Christopher Watt from the Police Advisory Board as he is leaving the community. Mr. Watt was serving as a school representative.

The City has also received a request of Carolyn Marlatt to be appointed to the Museum Board. The current vacancy is for a term expiring May 30, 2014.
