- The replacement of a water main on Grand Avenue between 10th and 12th Streets will begin on Monday, July 13th. Residents in the area will experience intermittent water outages during the project. Anyone wishing to replace their water service line during the construction process is encouraged to speak to the general contractor, K.L. - Shelter house rentals will continue to be conducted at the Municipal Building until further notice.
- The Husker Sports Network will be broadcasting its “Sports Nightly” program from the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center on Monday, July 13th from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. Husker fans are invited to attend the broadcast, get some autographs and make some noise for the fans listening across the state.
- The City of Alliance is requesting cooperation from our citizens regarding the maintenance of the Central Park Fountain. Individuals have been swimming in or allowing their pets to swim in the fountain. Swimming is not allowed in Central Park Fountain! The water filtration and disinfection system is not designed to eliminate contaminants introduced by swimmers such as germs and other transmittable infections and chlorine is not used on a regular basis.
