B. Ordinance No. 2643 – Second Reading

Municipal Code Amendment - Motel Occupancy Tax

Ordinance No. 2643 has been prepared at Council's request and is before you for second reading. This Ordinance will amend the Alliance Municipal Code by adding an article to Chapter 2 regarding a Motel Occupancy Tax.

C. Ordinance No. 2641 – Third Reading

Municipal Code Amendment – Requests to be Placed on Council Agendas

Ordinance No. 2641 is before Council on third reading. This ordinance will amend the Alliance Municipal Code at Chapter 1, Article 1, Sections 104 and 112. The amendment will require individuals desiring to be on a Council agenda to make their request seven business days prior to the meeting. This will allow staff to review the request, prepare any necessary materials and distribute within the normal agenda preparation schedule. In some cases the request may be able to be handled administratively without Council action.

D. Resolution No. 09-87A & B – Request of Habitat for Humanity

Habitat for Humanity is requesting the building permit fees be waived on their next house which will be located at 1407 Big Horn Avenue. Staff has prepared two resolutions for Council's consideration the first 09-87A will authorize the waiving of the fees; the second 09-87B denies the request.

E. Resolution No. 09-88 – Museum Capital Funds

Resolution No. 09-88 will authorize the acceptance of a donation from Box Butte General Hospital of a storage system. The resolution also grants authority to expend \$14,000.00 for the removal, transportation and installation of the unit in the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center. Funding is available for this project by using the funds budgeted for the Heritage Room Storage which is no longer needed as the room is complete.

F. Resolution No. 09-89 – Request of Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #51A

This resolution will acknowledge the renewal of the existing contract between the City of Alliance and the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #51A according to its terms. The contract was due to expire on September 30, 2009.
