The City of Alliance Street Crack Repair and Chip Seal Project has begun and will be completed on Friday, September 11<sup>th</sup>. The affected streets are as follows: Cheyenne Drive, Lakefield Drive West, Margaret Circle, Margaret Drive, 29<sup>th</sup> Street Circle, 29<sup>th</sup> Street, 21<sup>st</sup> Street, 20<sup>th</sup> Street, Box Butte Avenue between 21<sup>st</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> Streets, Big Horn Avenue between 21<sup>st</sup> Street and Burnham Drive, Burnham Drive between Big Horn and Emerson Avenue. To minimize inconvenience during the project, short-term detours will be used which may cause minor traffic delays. Please exercise caution while driving through construction areas.
