- Two projects are currently underway at Laing Lake Park. The existing gravel surfacing under the playground equipment will be removed and replaced with a recycled rubber surfacing. The area will be closed during the removal to ensure user safety. Parks staff will also be installing floating strobes on Laing Lake in an effort to reduce the goose population. The strobes are specifically designed to interrupt sleeping patterns of the geese throughout the night. The consistent interruption “encourages” them to continue migrating south rather than wintering in Alliance.
