**D. Public Hearing - Ordinance No. 2650 – Second Reading  
Comprehensive Plan Adoption**

Now is the date, time, and place to conduct a Public Hearing on the proposed Comprehensive Development Plan. Ordinance No. 2650 is before Council on second reading.

**E. Ordinance No. 2644 – Second Reading  
Municipal Code Amendment – Tree Surgeon's License**

Ordinance No. 2644 is before Council on second reading. This ordinance deals with the requirements of a Tree Surgeon's License and a Nursery – Greenhouse Permit. Language in Section 2-321 has been modified based on your discussion at the last meeting and if acceptable, will need an amendment.

**F. Ordinance No. 2652 – Second Reading  
Municipal Code Amendment – Dog Park Rules and Regulations**

Ordinance No. 2652 is before Council on second reading and will create an Article 3 within Chapter 7 of the Alliance Municipal Code. This Article provides for the establishment of rules and regulations regarding the operation and maintenance of a dog park.

**G. Resolution No. 09-112 – Review of Conditional Use Permit of KAB**

Resolution No. 09-112 is before Council and will authorize an additional year on the Conditional Use Permit of Barry Harris as property owner on behalf of Keep Alliance Beautiful. The Conditional Use Permit allows the operation of a recycling center at Lot 4, Block 27, Original Town, Alliance, NE. The center is located on the alley between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Streets west of Niobrara Avenue. Community Development Director Rick Houck as prepared a review of the property which has been included in the packet. The original Condition Use Permit was authority by Council on November 10, 2008 with the adoption of Resolution No. 08-108.

**H. Resolution No. 09-113 – IMLS Museum Grant**

This resolution will authorize staff to submit a grant application to the Institute of Museum and Library Services in the amount of \$150,000.00. If successful, funds received from this grant will be utilized to complete the display exhibits, interpretive material and furnishing of the interior of the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center.

**I. Resolution No. 09-114 – First Quarter CIP/CEP Authorization**

Resolution 09-114 will authorize staff to begin soliciting bids for equipment and services for the items identified on the attached listing. The items are identified by fund for a Grand Total of \$307,200.00. Several of these items will be bid during the first quarter; however will not be paid for until a later quarter.
