The operating hours of the Alliance Landfill are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Please bring documentation with you to verify that you are a resident of the City of Alliance.

Keep Alliance Beautiful will be conducting a Community Clean Up Day on Saturday, April 23rd. If you would like to help, please bring your gloves to the Municipal Building located at 324 Laramie at 9:00 a.m. Volunteers will be cleaning up a variety of public areas around the city.
