Saturday, April 30th is the last day to participate in the 2011 Clean Up Days and bring any items normally accepted at the Municipal Landfill for disposal at no cost with the exception of tires, appliances and construction and demolition materials. Clean Up Days are for residential customers of the City of Alliance only. All business and commercial companies will be required to pay normal landfill disposal fees. The operating hours of the Alliance Landfill are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Please bring documentation with you to verify that you are a resident of the City of Alliance.
