The Alliance City Council met in a Special Joint Meeting, May 24, 2011 at 12:00 p.m., at the Knight Museum, 904 Yellowstone Avenue. A notice of meeting was published in the Alliance Times Herald on May 17, 2011. The notice stated the date, hour and place of the meeting, that the meeting was open to the public, and that an agenda of the meeting, kept continuously current, was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk in City Hall; provided the Council could modify the agenda at the meeting if it determined an emergency so required. A similar notice, together with a copy of the agenda, also had been delivered to each of the City Council Members.
