The Alliance City Council met in a Special Meeting, July 21, 2011 at 1:00 p.m., at the Regional Law Enforcement Center, 512 Niobrara Avenue. A notice of meeting was published in the Alliance Times Herald on July 14, 2011. The notice stated the purpose of the meeting was to tour the facility for potential future space needs and improvements. The meeting was open to the public.

Mayor Feldges opened the July 21, 2011 Special Meeting of the Alliance, Nebraska City Council at 1:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Feldges, Council Members Kusek, and Gonzalez. Council Members Benzel and Yeager were absent. Also present was City Manager Cox. A posting of the Open Meetings Act was posted for public review.

- It was reported to Council that the facility was constructed in 1978 as a joint project between Box Butte County and the City of Alliance. The original Construction Agreement was signed between the entities in 1975 and the latest Building Use Agreement was executed in November, 1987.

Council toured the following areas: investigation, Chief's office, Operations Commander's office, secretarial space, storage closets, squad room, sergeants' office, interview room, bathrooms, police communications, sheriff's communications, evidence room, and the emergency generator. The lack of space, handicap accessibility, area for expansion and storage were pointed out.

- Mayor Feldges stated, "there being no further business to come before the Alliance City Council, the meeting is adjourned at 1:50 p.m."
