Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report

Children are invited to trick or treat at the Alliance Police Department from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. on Halloween! Treats will be available for the kids, as well as coffee for the adults! Officers would like to remind children to trick or treat only in areas that they are familiar with, avoid unlighted houses, and always have an adult check their treats before eating them.

To regulate traffic flow and make snow removal more efficient, the parking or storing of any bus, semi, truck, tractor cab unit, trailer, utility trailer, recreational vehicle, camper, travel trailer, boat, personal water craft, trailered barbeques and all other similar items intended for attachment to a vehicle is prohibited between November 1st of each year through May 1st of the following year. If not removed from City streets, these items may be towed at the owner's expense and a citation may be issued.

The undecorated trees and wreaths for the 16th Annual Christmas Tree and Wreath Festival which will be held December 3rd through December 10th will be available for pickup on Thursday, November 3rd at the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center. The museum is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Beginning Tuesday, November 1st, winter rates will be in effect at Sky View Golf Course. Green fees are \$13.00 per day through February.

The Alliance Public Library will be hosting a movie party for all children in grades K-5 on Monday, October 31st from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. in the Library meeting rooms! They will be showing "Hocus Pocus" using their new projector that will provide a theater size screen! The movie and popcorn are free and the kids are invited to come in costume!
