The Alliance Police Department has received the new 2012 licensing stickers for All Terrain Vehicles. The registration fee is \$25.00. ATV's must be brought to the Police Department for inspection and insurance documentation is required. ATV's must have headlights, tail lights, and must be equipped with a bicycle safety flag which extends no less than six feet above ground. Registrations may be purchased seven days a week at the Law Enforcement Center located at 512 Niobrara.
