The Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles has recently implemented a new Online Handicap Permit Issuing System for accepting and processing applications for handicapped parking permits from allowed health care providers. Anyone wishing to apply for a new Handicap Parking permit or renew an existing permit can request that their medical professional file for it electronically. This service will eliminate the need to obtain an application form from the City Clerk or County Treasurer for the doctor's signature and will shorten the application processing time significantly. Information is available at the City of Alliance Municipal Building for applicants to present to their doctor regarding the new process.
