Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report

Children are invited to trick or treat at the Alliance Police Department from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. on Halloween! Treats will be available for the kids, as well as coffee for the adults! Officers would like to remind children to trick or treat only in areas that they are familiar with, avoid unlighted houses and always have an adult check their treats before eating them.

The Alliance Volunteer Fire Department "Haunted Hotel" will be open tonight and Saturday, October 27th from 7:00 to 11:00 p.m. on the second floor of 318 Box Butte Avenue. Those planning to attend either night must be at least 13 years of age unless accompanied by an adult. Admission is \$7.00 per person or \$5.00 per person with a canned food donation. Trick or Treat with the monster for children younger than 13 years of age will be held on Sunday, October 28th from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m. with free admission with a canned food donation. All canned food donations will be given to the Northwest Community Action Partnership food pantry.

To regulate traffic flow and make snow removal more efficient, the parking or storing of any bus, semi, truck, tractor cab unit, trailer, utility trailer, recreational vehicle, camper, travel trailer, boat, personal water craft, trailered barbeques and all other similar items intended for attachment to a vehicle is prohibited between November 1st of each year through May 1st of the following year. If not removed from City streets, these items may be towed at the owner's expense and a citation may be issued.
