2013 Sky View Golf Course memberships, cart barn storage fees and locker room rental fees may be paid at the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday.

Yard waste collection will begin on Tuesday, April 2nd for the alley dumpsters and Wednesday, April 3rd for the blue roll out containers. The regular trash receptacles will be emptied before the yard waste containers. Yard and garden waste must be placed in the dumpsters loose, not in a plastic bag which hinders the composting process. Sticks should be broken into small pieces and placed in the regular dumpsters and not in the yard and garden waste containers.
