The City of Alliance is currently accepting applications for summer lifeguard positions at Big Blue Bay. Applications are available at Workforce Development, in the City Clerk's office at 324 Laramie or on the City's website at www.cityofalliance.net.

The Community Development Department would like to encourage residents to call Digger's Hotline at 1-800-331-5666 prior to planting trees or beginning any type of building projects this spring to avoid damaging any underground lines. Residents should also contact the Community Development Department at 762-5400 to obtain the proper building permits before beginning construction.

Residents of the City of Alliance are encouraged to participate in the 2013 Clean Up Days from Tuesday, April 30th through Saturday, May 4th. During Clean Up Days, residents will be allowed to bring any items normally accepted at the Municipal Landfill for disposal at no cost with the exception of tires, hazardous materials and construction and demolition materials. Clean Up Days are for residential customers of the City of Alliance only. All business and commercial companies will be required to pay normal landfill disposal fees. The operating hours of the Alliance Landfill are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Please bring documentation with you to verify that you are a resident of the City of Alliance. If you have no way to transport your items to the landfill, you may contact Keep Alliance Beautiful at 762-1729 to schedule a pick up. After scheduling your pick up, please place the items at curbside and plan to be present while crews are loading the truck.
