Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report

Season passes for the 2013 swimming season will be available beginning May 13th from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center only. Please bring a 1"x1" photo of each individual pass holder. If you do not have the necessary photos, they may be taken for a \$2.00 fee per photo. Prices for season passes are as follows: Household pass - \$130.00; 17 and under - \$50.00; 18 and older - \$70.00; Lap swim only - \$35.00. Big Blue Bay is scheduled to open Saturday, May 25th if weather conditions and water temperature permits. For more information, please contact the museum at 762-2384.

The City of Alliance is currently accepting applications for summer lifeguard positions at Big Blue Bay. Applications are available at Workforce Development, in the City Clerk's office at 324 Laramie or on the City's website at www.cityofalliance.net.

Red Cross Swimming lesson sign up is available at the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center until Friday, May 10th at 5:00 p.m. The cost is \$30.00 per child and payment is required at the time of registration. No registrations will be accepted after that date.

Residents of the City of Alliance are encouraged to participate in the 2013 Clean Up Days from Tuesday, April 30th through Saturday, May 4th. During Clean Up Days, residents will be allowed to bring any items normally accepted at the Municipal Landfill for disposal at no cost with the exception of tires, hazardous materials and construction and demolition materials. Clean Up Days are for residential customers of the City of Alliance only. All business and commercial companies will be required to pay normal landfill disposal fees. The operating hours of the Alliance Landfill are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Please bring documentation with you to verify that you are a resident of the City of Alliance. If you have no way to transport your items to the landfill, you may contact Keep Alliance Beautiful at 762-1729 to schedule a pick up. After scheduling your pick up, please place the items at curbside and plan to be present while crews are loading the truck.
