**Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report**

Season passes for the 2013 swimming season are now available from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center only. Please bring a 1"x1" photo of each individual pass holder. If you do not have the necessary photos, they may be taken for a \$2.00 fee per photo. Prices for season passes are as follows: Household pass - \$130.00; 17 and under - \$50.00; 18 and older - \$70.00; Lap swim only - \$35.00. Big Blue Bay is scheduled to open Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup> if weather conditions and water temperature permits. For more information, please contact the museum at 762-2384.

Applications and agreements for Community Garden plots are available in the City Clerk's office located at 324 Laramie. All applications must be submitted with payment in full. The prices are \$30.00 for a 200 square foot plot and \$50.00 for a 400 square foot plot. The Community Garden is located on the 2700 block of Big Horn Avenue. Garden plots are limited and will be assigned on a first come basis.

The public is invited to attend an informational meeting on Tuesday, May 21<sup>st</sup> from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center regarding street projects on Emerson Avenue from 18<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> Street and Potash Street from Kansas Avenue to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.
