Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report

The City of Alliance is accepting applications for the positions of Facility Maintenance Worker I, Public Safety Dispatcher and Building and Zoning Inspector. For complete job descriptions, please contact Workforce Development or access the City of Alliance website at www.cityofalliance.net.

In an effort to streamline the traffic flow at the Alliance Middle School, a “No Left Turn” sign has been posted at the intersection of West 11th Street and Box Butte Avenue to help prevent congestion. Officers will be posted at the intersection to assist with any questions.

To regulate traffic flow and make snow removal more efficient, the parking or storing of any bus, semi, truck, tractor cab unit, trailer, utility trailer, recreational vehicle, camper, travel trailer, boat, personal water craft, trailered barbeques and all other similar items intended for attachment to a vehicle is prohibited between November 1st of each year through May 1st of the following year. If not removed from City streets, these items may be towed at the owner’s expense and a citation may be issued.

The Nebraska of Roads Traffic Counter Shop will be setting up portable traffic counters at a variety of locations in the City of Alliance next week, weather permitting. Hoses will be placed across the roadways at each of the locations for a minimum of 48 hours.

The City of Alliance will continue collecting yard waste through Wednesday, November 20th. If your yard waste container is full prior to regular refuse collection days, you may take your yard waste to the landfill at no charge.
