Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report

In an effort to streamline the traffic flow at the Alliance Middle School, a “Right Turn Only” sign has been posted at the intersection of West 11th Street and Box Butte Avenue to help prevent congestion. A turning arrow has also been painted on the street to guide traffic. Officers will be posted at the intersection to assist with any questions.

To regulate traffic flow and make snow removal more efficient, the parking or storing of any bus, semi, truck, tractor cab unit, trailer, utility trailer, recreational vehicle, camper, travel trailer, boat, personal water craft, trailered barbeques and all other similar items intended for attachment to a vehicle is prohibited between November 1st of each year through May 1st of the following year. If not removed from City streets, these items may be towed at the owner’s expense and a citation may be issued.

The Alliance Public Library is having a pumpkin decorating contest for kids as well as adults! Pumpkins and Funkins will be accepted and displayed from Friday, October 25th through Halloween.
