Terry Galloway of Almquist, Maltzahn, Galloway & Luth, P.C. will be in attendance to review the City of Alliance's Audit of the Financial Statements for the period October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013.

- F. Ordinance No. 2752 – First Reading**
Two Mile Zoning Jurisdiction
Ordinance No. 2752 is before Council on first reading and will establish the City's two-mile area of planning and zoning jurisdiction outside our corporate boundary. The new two-mile area will include Carhenge which was previously excluded and a new area as a result of annexation.
- G. Resolution No. 14-28 – Interlocal Agreement for Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation**
Resolution No. 14-28 will authorize the City of Alliance to enter into an Interlocal Agreement for the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. The resolution also names Fire Chief Troy Shoemaker as the City Manager's appointee, with City Manager J.D. Cox as the alternate.
- H. Request of Fraternal Order of Police 51A and 51B**
The City of Alliance has received a request from the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) Lodges 51A and 51B to consider and take action on merging into one lodge. City Attorney Olsen will be making a presentation to Council regarding this matter.

I. Board Vacancies

Two individuals have expressed an interest to fill the one remaining vacancy for a term expiring February 28, 2014 on the Alliance Park and Tree Board. A candidate listing has been provided within your packet for consideration and selection.

The City has been notified that Deborah Feller has resigned from her position as Main Street Director and is no longer eligible to serve on the A-2 Downtown Improvement Board. Ms. Feller's term was to October 31, 2014. The City has also become aware that Dr. Paul Willette has left the community, which leaves a vacancy on the Golf Advisory Board for a term which expires December 31, 2014.

The City of Alliance continues to have vacancies on the A-1 and A-2 Downtown Improvement Board, the Economic Development Plan Citizen Advisory Board, Golf Course Advisory Board, and a homemaker representative on the Police Advisory Board.
