Attention Golfers: 2013 Sky View Golf Course memberships will expire on March 31<sup>st</sup>! 2014 memberships may be purchased at the course. Rates are as follows: Single \$457.00; Student \$147.00; Couple \$657.00; Family \$783.00. Green fees are \$17.00 for 9 holes and \$23.00 for 18 holes March through October. Green fees will be charged to anyone not having a current membership.

Yard waste collection will begin on Tuesday, April 1<sup>st</sup> for the alley dumpsters and Wednesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> for the blue roll out containers. The regular trash receptacles will be emptied before the yard waste containers. Yard and garden waste must be placed in the dumpsters loose, not in a plastic bag which hinders the composting process. Sticks should be broken into small pieces and placed in the regular dumpsters and not in the yard and garden waste containers.
