Did you know that you can dispose of your unwanted furniture and appliances at the City of Alliance Landfill for a nominal fee? Disposal of furniture is charged at the minimum charge of \$7.60. Appliances with no Freon may be taken to the landfill for \$10.00 and appliances with Freon for \$25.00. A complete listing of disposal fees may be found on the city's website at cityofalliance.net. The landfill is open for your convenience Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
