Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report

Saturday, May 10th is the last day for residential utility customers of the City of Alliance to participate in the 2014 Green Up Clean Up Days. During Green Up Clean Up Days, residents will be allowed to bring any items normally accepted at the Municipal Landfill for disposal at no cost with the exception of tires, hazardous materials and construction and demolition materials. The operating hours of the Alliance Landfill are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Please bring documentation with you to verify that you are a resident of the City of Alliance.

Red Cross swimming lesson sign up is available at the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center until 5:00 p.m. today. The cost is \$30.00 per child and payment is required at the time of registration. No registrations will be accepted after that date.

Payment in full must accompany all submitted applications. The prices are \$25.00 for a 200 square foot plot; \$40.00 for a 400 square foot plot and \$50.00 for a 500 square foot plot. The Community Garden is located on the 2700 block of Big Horn Avenue. Garden plots are limited and will be assigned on a first come basis.
