Prices for season passes are as follows: Household pass – \$130.00; 17 and under - \$50.00; 18 and older - \$70.00; Lap swim only - \$35.00. The City of Alliance Water Department would like to remind all water customers that local ordinance requires the installation of hose bib vacuum breakers on all hose spigots and water hydrants. Devices may be purchased at local hardware and plumbing supply outlets. This device may cause a slight reduction of water pressure.

The Community Development Department would like to remind everyone that the City of Alliance has adopted an article in the Municipal Code with regards to accessory parking structures in residential zoning. This includes detached garages and carports. Code requires them to be constructed of materials and color matching the residence.
