

Resolution No. 14-81**  
Now is the date, time and place to conduct a Public Hearing to consider and approve the Class C Liquor License Application of El Ramo De Guadalupe LLC dba El Ramo De Guadalupe Mexican Restaurant, 1203 West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Avenue, Alliance, NE. Material included for Council's review are the application, background report from Police Chief Kiss and the check list per Section 53-132 of the Nebraska State Statutes. Representatives of El Ramo De Guadalupe Mexican Restaurant have been advised to be in attendance.
- D. Resolution No. 14-82 – City Council Contingency Fund Authorization**  
Resolution No. 14-82 will authorize the use and transfer of \$7,000 from the City Council Contingency Fund to the RSVP Fund for the administration and operation of the Handyman Program. The City was recently awarded the Program by the Aging Office of Western Nebraska.
- E. Establish a Date for the Budget Workshop**  
Staff is recommending Council establish a date to conduct a Budget Workshop during the week of July 21<sup>st</sup>. The Workshop is estimated to be approximately two hours. Initial contact with Council members suggests that either Monday the 21<sup>st</sup> or Tuesday the 22<sup>nd</sup> late afternoon would work best.
- F. Board Vacancies**  
The City has been notified that Mr. Gary Leever has been selected as the new President of the Panhandle Mens Association and therefore would now replace Mr. Tyre on the Golf Course Advisory Board for a term expiring December 31, 2015. The City has also received an application from Carol Bauer to serve on the same Board of which there is a vacancy with a term expiring December 31, 2014. Copies of their applications have been made available to Council for your consideration.

The City of Alliance continues to have one vacancy on the Community Garden Advisory Board, one vacancy each on the Downtown Improvement Boards, two vacancies on the Economic Development Plan Citizen Advisory Board and two vacancies on the Police Advisory Board, a school representative and a homemaker representative.
