City crews will begin picking up Christmas trees today and will conclude on Friday, January 2nd. Trees to be collected must be undecorated and cannot be in plastic bags or other containers as they interfere with processing. If you would like your tree collected, please place your undecorated Christmas tree on the parkade near the street in front of your residence and the Street Division will pick it up. Trees will not be collected from alleys and should not be placed in dumpsters or roll out containers.

The Alliance Municipal Landfill will be open Friday, December 26th and Friday, January 2nd from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday, December 27th and Saturday, January 3rd from 8:00 a.m. to noon.
