Registrations for Red Cross swimming lessons will be available during the Health Fair in the Alliance High gymnasium on Saturday, March 21 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Payment of \$30.00 is required at the time of registration. Please bring the most recently issued Red Cross card and completed registration form with you to the Health Fair to expedite the registration process. No early registrations or phone registrations will be accepted.

Yard waste collection will begin on Tuesday, March 31 for the alley dumpsters and Wednesday, April 1 for the blue roll out containers. The regular trash receptacles will be emptied before the yard waste containers. Yard and garden waste must be placed in the dumpsters loose, not in a plastic bag which hinders the composting process. Sticks should be broken into small pieces and placed in the regular dumpsters and not in the yard and garden waste containers.
