Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report

Red Cross Swimming Lesson registration will continue at the Knight Museum and Sandhills Center. Payment of \$30.00 is required at the time of registration. The registration form and a complete schedule are available on the City of Alliance website at www.cityofalliance.net under Cultural and Leisure Services Department. Please bring the most recently issued Red Cross card and completed registration form with you. No telephone registrations will be accepted.

Yard waste collection will begin on Tuesday, March 31 for the alley dumpsters and Wednesday, April 1 for the blue roll out containers. The regular trash receptacles will be emptied before the yard waste containers. Yard and garden waste must be placed in the dumpsters loose, not in a plastic bag which hinders the composting process. Sticks should be broken into small pieces and placed in the regular dumpsters and not in the yard and garden waste containers.

Attention Golfers! 2014 Sky View Golf Course memberships will expire on March 31! 2015 memberships may be purchased at the course. Rates are as follows: Single \$457.00; Student \$147.00; Couple \$657.00; Family \$783.00. Green fees are \$17.00 for 9 holes and \$23.00 for 18 holes March through October. Green fees will be charged to anyone not having a current membership.

The refuse trucks are not designed to process building materials. Please take all construction and demolition debris directly to the landfill for disposal.
