The initial schedule will feature a combination of non-stop and one-stop flights connecting Alliance and Denver. Fireworks may not be discharged after midnight on July 4. Please practice safety while discharging fireworks and remember that the use, purchase or possession of fireworks by any person under 12 years of age is prohibited unless direct supervision is provided by a person 18 years of age or older.

All City offices will be closed Friday, July 3. Regular business hours will resume on Monday, July 6.
