In an effort to ensure clear access to sidewalks, streets and alleys, the City of Alliance is asking that residents trim the limbs, branches or foliage of any trees on their property to create a clearance of eight feet above any public sidewalk and 13½ feet above the surface of a street, lane or alley. A list of trees that are recommended by the Nebraska Statewide Arboretum for planting in parkade areas is available on the City's webpage.

City of Alliance Street crews have begun painting crosswalks in preparation for the upcoming school year. Please exercise caution while driving near work areas.
