Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report

The Community Development Department would like to remind residents of the City of Alliance that metal carports are permitted in residential areas only after the issuance of a building permit. Drawings for the structure and a site plan are required before any building permit will be issued. Carports constructed without a building permit will be required to be removed at the City's insistence if it does not meet code. The Alliance Municipal Landfill will be closed on Saturday, October 17. The landfill will reopen on Monday, October 19 at 8:00 a.m.
