- D. Resolution No. 16-23 – Special Designated Liquor License for Alliance Grocery Kart, Inc.**  
Resolution No. 16-23 will grant a Special Designated Liquor License to Alliance Grocery Kart, Inc. for their grand opening event on March 18, 2016. The license will allow the store to provide tastings for a two hour period between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- E. Resolution No. 16-24 – Participation in the Western Nebraska Golf Card Program**  
This resolution will grant permission to the City to include SkyView Golf Course in the 2016 Western Nebraska Golf Card Program. The Program allows individuals to purchase a card for \$79.00 which will allow them to play participating Western Nebraska courses one time each during the season for half price. Currently there are at least ten courses participating.
- F. Resolution No. 16-25 – Landscape Services Bid Award**  
Resolution No. 16-25 will award the City's Landscaping Services Contract to All Seasons Landscaping in the amount of \$31,590. The contract term is March through October, 2016 and includes a three-year renewal option.
- G. Resolution No. 16-26 – Landfill Conveyor Repairs**  
City Manager Cox has authorized the repair of the Landfill conveyor belt system due to a catastrophic failure. Resolution No. 16-26 is before Council and will ratify City Manager Cox's previous action and authorize the transfer of \$44,000 from the Capital Improvements Account to the Capital Equipment Account for the Landfill Fund to cover the cost of the necessary repair.

Four applications have been received for the two vacancies on the Alliance Park and Tree Board. The vacancies are for three years. A ballot has been prepared for Council's convenience if you so choose. Copies of each of the applications are part of the packet.


John Aguallo has applied to serve on the Economic Development Plan Citizen Advisory Board. The current vacancy is for a term expiring December 31, 2018.
