The City of Alliance is offering eight (8) tracts of grazing land and one (1) tract of haying land for lease. Complete information is available in the Airport Manager's office in the Airport Terminal Building or by calling Lynn Placek at 762-4512.

June 20 through July 1
- Level Five – July 11 through July 22
