Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report

Construction has begun on the Alliance Asphalt Overlay Project. Work will include milling the existing pavement to match grades at the edges of the roadway and overlaying the existing streets with asphalt. The streets to be repaired include:

18th Street – Emerson Avenue to End of Asphalt Pavement

18th Terrace Place

Platte Avenue - 16th Street to 18th Street

Black Hills Court Cul-de-sac

E. 3rd Street - Flack Avenue to Elkhorn Avenue

6th Street – Ramblin Road to Buffalo Avenue

Most roadways under construction will remain open to local traffic, however delays should be expected. While work is being performed on the Black Hills Court cul-de-sac and 18th Terrace Place, roadways will be closed to all traffic.
