- E. Ordinance No. 2800 – Third Reading**  
**Municipal Code Amendment – Entertainment District**  
  
Ordinance No. 2800 is before Council on third reading. This ordinance will add a section to our current Alliance Municipal Code to allow for an Entertainment District for the sale of alcohol during public events. An amendment has been suggested for Council's consideration to change the zoning district from C-1 to any commercial zone which will allow for an Entertainment District.

Resolution No. 16-49 will adopt the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program which is required when receiving Federal funds. This program is to ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of U.S. Department of Transportation assisted contracts.


