Residents with tree limbs from the recent snow storm are asked to place the limbs in the curb strip area near the street and call the Public Works Facility at 762-1907 to report your name and address to arrange for pick up of the tree branches. Branches will not be picked up from the alleys.

The City of Alliance would like to remind residents that trees need to be trimmed to provide clearance of eight feet above sidewalks and 13 ½ feet above street, lane or alley surfaces and grass and weeds should be kept cut to a height of no more than eight inches. Noxious weeds should be controlled by the property owner to prevent spreading.

The Municipal Code has been amended with regard to the parking and or storing of any trailer, utility trailer, recreational vehicle, camper, travel trailer, boat, personal water craft, trailered barbeques and all other items intended for attachment to a vehicle on city streets. The parking of these items on a city street for a period of more than 24 hours is prohibited. Trailers used by contractors with the issuance of a building permit or a parking permit shall be allowed as long as the permit remains in place and the location does not interfere with required driveway and vision requirements. Applications for Trailer Parking Permits for contractors may be found on the City of Alliance website or in the Community Development office.

Big Blue Bay is scheduled to open Saturday, May 28 if weather conditions and water temperature permits. 2016 season passes will be available at the Knight Museum & Sandhills Center beginning Monday, May 9 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Season passes will **not** be sold at Big Blue Bay. Please bring an individual 1" x 1" photo of each pass holder. If you do not have the necessary photos, they can be taken at the museum for a \$2.00 fee per photo. Prices for season passes are as follows:

Household pass - \$130.00
17 and under - \$50.00
18 and older - \$70.00
Lap Swim Only - \$35.00
