In an effort to improve our community's aesthetic appeal, we would like to remind you that vehicle parking is no longer allowed in the curb strip (parkade) area.

In an effort to provide maximum visibility for pedestrians and motorists, approval must be obtained from the Cultural and Leisure Services Director prior to planting vegetation in the curb strip area. Only ornamental annual and perennial plants and grasses with a maximum height of 36 inches or less may be planted in the curb strip area. Trees in the curb strip are restricted by variety due to clearance and line of site issues. A list of approved trees that have been recommended for western Nebraska by the Nebraska Statewide Arboretum is available on the City of Alliance website under the Living In tab.
