The coupon must be presented to the landfill attendant at the time of use. The landfill is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. and Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Compost is now available at the Alliance Municipal Landfill for \$10.00 per ton.
