**Welcome to the City of Alliance Activity Report**

The Alliance Police Department would like to advise citizens of a telephone scam currently being reported involving the Internal Revenue Service. The caller identifies themselves as the IRS indicating that money may be due. The Internal Revenue Service does **not** contact individuals by telephone. Please do not provide personal information to anyone calling your number.

All City of Alliance offices will be closed on Monday, July 4. Regular business hours will resume on Tuesday, July 5.

The Knight Museum and Sandhills Center will be open from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 3 and Monday, July 4.

Sky View Golf Course will host the Panhandle Men's Club 4-Man Scramble on Monday, July 4 and the Panhandle Junior Golf Tour on Tuesday, July 5. The course will remain open to the general public.

The Alliance Jaycees will present their annual community fireworks display on Monday, July 4 at Laing Lake beginning at dusk.

The Sallows Military Museum located at 1100 Niobrara Avenue will be hosting a book signing by Lieutenant Colonel George A. Larson, author of Great Plains Warriors of World War II on Tuesday, July 5 from noon until 2:00 p.m.

In accordance with city ordinances and state regulations, fireworks may be legally discharged in the City of Alliance until July 2 from 9:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. and July 3 and 4 from 9:00 a.m. until 12 midnight. Fireworks may not be discharged after midnight on July 4. Please practice safety while discharging fireworks and remember, that the use, purchase or possession of fireworks by any person under 12 years of age is prohibited unless direct supervision is provided by a person 18 years of age or older.

The Friends of the Library will be hosting a craft class for kids ages 8 and older on Wednesday, July 20 from 2:00 to 4:30 p.m. The cost for the class is \$10.00 and class size is limited. Participants must pre-register at the front desk of the library.

The Alliance City Council will conduct a regular meeting on Tuesday, July 5 at 7:00 p.m. in the Board of Education meeting room located at 1604 Sweetwater Avenue. Complete agendas and minutes may be viewed on the City's web page.

City of Alliance Utility customers will receive two (2) landfill passes in the mail that may be used at the Alliance Municipal Landfill for a period of one year and will expire on June 30, 2017. Normal household items will be accepted; however tires, appliances and construction or demolition debris will not qualify. The coupons are personalized and are not transferable. The coupon must be presented to the landfill attendant at the time of use. The landfill is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. and Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
