Municipal Code Amendment - Prohibited Activities within Municipal Parks

Ordinance No. 2920 is before Council on first reading and will prohibit motorized and non-motorized recreation vehicles such as, but not limited to, skateboards, bicycles, skates, within municipal parks.

C. Resolution No. 21-68 - Bid Award for Burlington Avenue Paving Project

Resolution No. 21-68 will award the Burlington Avenue Paving Project to Peltz Companies of Alliance in the amount of \$382,353.
