

Exhibit G: Urgent Need Certification and Documentation

To comply with the national objective of meeting community development needs having a particular urgency, an activity must be designed to alleviate existing conditions which the local government certifies all of the items in the **AmpliFund** form, which include:

1. The condition/situation poses a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community
2. The condition/situation is of recent origin or recently became urgent. A condition will generally be considered to be of recent origin if it developed or became critical within 18 months preceding the date of this certification ([24 CFR 570.483\(d\)](#)), and certified by the State.
3. The local unit of government is unable to finance the activity on its own.
4. The CDBG Activity funding requested is designed to address the urgent need.

***NOTE:** Activities designated solely to **prevent** a serious health or welfare threat from developing in the future will not qualify under this criterion.
